A good spread of deck seating modules and storage options will enable customers to configure the boat precisely according to their needs. The picture below presents the optional multi-storage compartment with seating (either for four seated sideways or two facing forward with sun pad rearwards), or the forward-facing rear bench seat for two-people as standard.



A full width cushioned sundeck is positioned atop the cabin roof, with a sloping back rest that follows the rake of the front screen.





The cushioned sundeck atop the sleeping cabin invites to hangout and socialise with friends or lay back and enjoy the surroundings with chilled refreshments by your side.
